Quote Type Definitions

- **ON-NET:** The Primary Contractor will be proposing a direct connection to On-Net Internet Access Services, which is *in the Primary Contractor's service area*. This excludes any fiber construction services and/or special construction.
- ****OFF-NET:** The Primary Contractor will be proposing a direction connection to Off-Net Internet Access Services, which is *outside of the Primary Contractor's service area*. This may include fiber construction services and/or special construction, and to meet the applicant's need, this may include the Offeror partnering with other providers.


